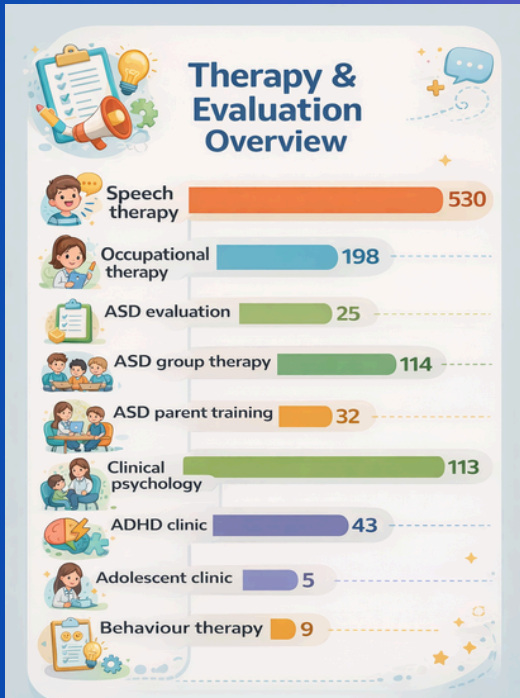


## Certificate Course in Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD)

The Child Development Centre (CDC) has started offering a six-month Certificate Course in Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) designed for professionals in healthcare, rehabilitation, and child development. The course provides a comprehensive understanding of the neurobiology, clinical features, and developmental trajectories of ASD, along with training in early identification, screening, and diagnostic tools. It combines one month of online theoretical learning with 60 days of supervised clinical training, ensuring hands-on exposure to evidence-based interventions, parent counselling, and multidisciplinary care. With a limited intake of 10 participants per batch, the program emphasizes individualized learning, clinical competence, and practical skills for delivering autism-specific services across diverse settings.
